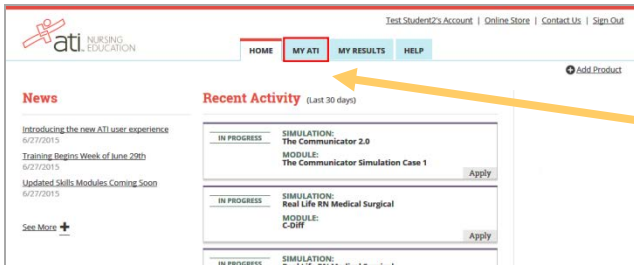


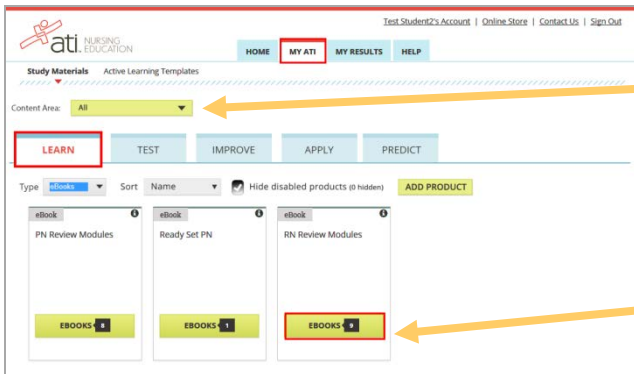
HOW TO ACCESS AN EBOOK

The **My ATI > LEARN** tab contains your eBooks. Each eBook provides instructional content, which is presented in a virtual textbook format, and media resources that are designed to supplement the textbook material.

To access your eBooks, sign on to www.atitesting.com with your account's Username and Password.

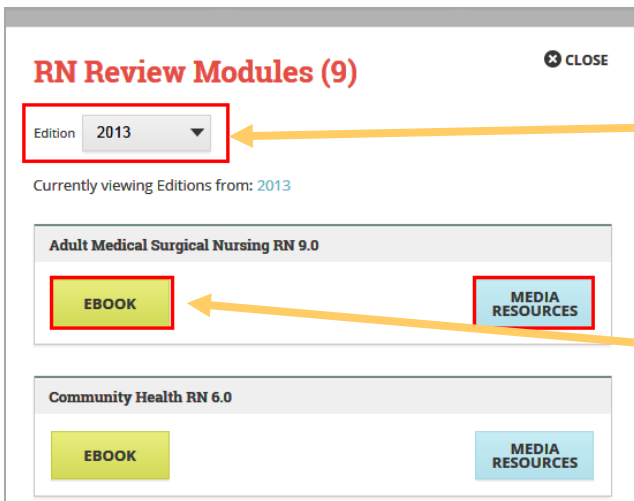


Your eBooks are located on the **MY ATI > LEARN** tab. The Learn window provides access to your Tutorials, Quiz Banks, eBooks, Virtual or Capstone classroom, and Flashcards for all topics.



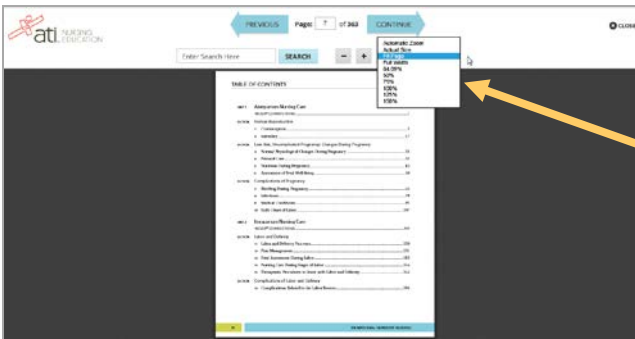
To help you find a particular eBook, you can filter by *Content Area*, by *Type* to display only eBooks or you can use the *Sort* list to display the product cards either by the date of last access or alphabetically by eBook name.

Your eBook product cards are distinguished from other cards by the dark green border at the top. The number on the **EBOOKS** button indicates the number of modules for that topic. Click **EBOOKS** to open a list of available modules.



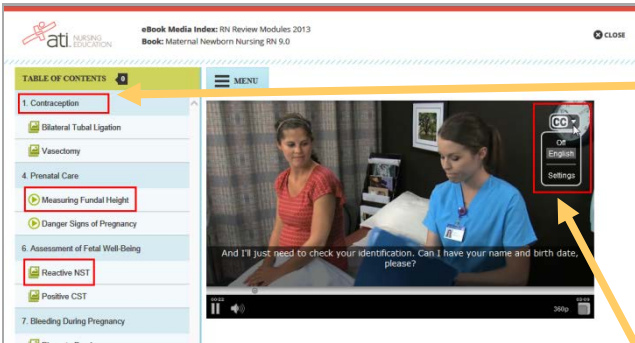
On the eBooks Module window, you can filter the list by *Edition*. The default will be the latest NCLEX test plan year currently available.

For each module, you have a choice to study the textbook information or to view situational videos. Click **EBOOK** to access the textbook material with embedded media as it relates to each topic or **MEDIA RESOURCES** to access the embedded rich media videos, animations, and graphs.

Use this drop-down list to adjust the page size for your device.



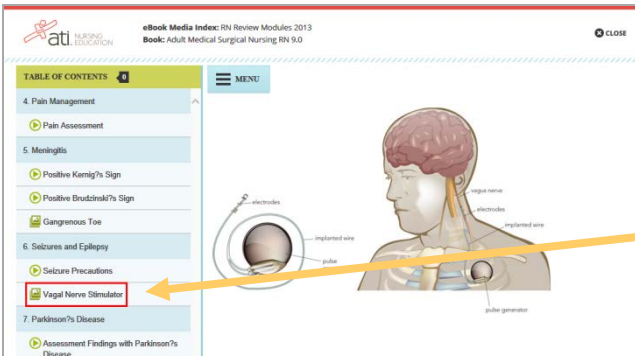
Media Resources contains both videos and other instructional materials, designed to supplement the eBook.
